Please find some very impawtant information to help you get organised and excited for the experience that awaits you!

GETTING TO CHI WOW WAH TOWN

If you haven't already, please get your plans sorted ASAP. The best ways to travel to CWWT are via Coach direct to/from Melbourne or the complimentary Shuttle bus from Benalla Train Station.

The shuttle and coach will stop via the supermarket, bottleshop and pharmacy in Benalla on the way to the event, so you can stock up on supplies and support the local businesses.

Please ensure to book your coach tickets or register for the free shuttle by next Wednesday (unless sold out prior).

BENALLA TRAIN STATION SHUTTLE

The most affordable & sustainable way to get to CHI WOW WAH TOWN is catching the VLine train service, ONLY \$10.60 each way!! Catch the train from either Southern Cross or Broadmeadows station and we will collect you from the Benalla train station. With a quick stop at the local supermarket to collect supplies before bringing you direct to the festival site. Services operate on Sunday & Monday for a safe journey home.

Head over to our Humanitix page for departure times and ensure you book your VLine ticket ASAP, VLine ticket reservations get booked out. We advise phoning VLine if there are no tickets available online.. Once you've booked, head over to our Humanitix page to register for your spot on the Shuttle Service of your choice (only after you have your V Line ticket). Please book asap!

VEHICLE PASS

LITTLE YAPPERS

In addition to our usual amazing stages, workshop and chill spaces, and camping, we've added in additional family camping, as well as a dedicated kids play station.

FAMILY CAMPING

Our allocated family camping is located in the quieter areas of camping amongst picturesque tree lines, which is further away from the event space, so keep that in mind when planning your experience.

Friends are permitted to camp with you in the family camping area, but please be mindful that these zones are allocated to cater for registered families and we will only be including limited extra space for friends of families. We suggest arriving early and securing positions close by for friends if you have a large group.

Due to the limitations of being on a nature reserve, we will have limited resources in campsites for families. However, we can accommodate those needing access to a kitchen with washing facilities can be provided access to our crew kitchen. Please go to the Info Tent when you arrive on site for further information.

We're excited to share our children's play station, which will be programmed with fun activities, craft, workshops, performances, face painting and so much more to keep those tiny hands and mind entertained.

CWWT KIDS GUIDELINES

Chi Wow Wah Town is a safe family-friendly environment for everyone to celebrate in, however it is important to be aware that:

- Children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian at all times.
- Children's wristbands with an attending parent's or legal guardian's contact number must be worn at all times.

- It's a big crowd and they will be camping in the middle of summer with limited facilities for 3 days.
- CWWT is a safe place, but wasn't originally designed with children in mind, so we expect guardians to ensure safety and care for the dependents at all times.
- Children may also be exposed to offensive language or behaviour. If you experience any offensive behaviour we urge you to contact a staff member to report it so we can continue to make it a safe space for all to attend. The festival organisers take no responsibility for what persons under 18 are exposed to and it is the complete responsibility of the parent or legal guardian.
- No cooking or open flames are permitted on the site, we will be working towards a community kitchen set up in the family & accessible camping space for families to access, and if not crew kitchen access will be granted.
- All children are expected to follow all terms and conditions as any other patron found at CWWT.

LOST CHILDREN

For any missing persons or children please report to the Info Tent or a security member immediately.

Please keep wristbands on children at all times so that parents can be easily contacted.

CHILDREN'S TICKETS

All children's tickets must be pre-purchased a ticket and complete this registration form at the time of purchase (https://docs.google.com/forms/d/1TLgXPYV2tKgWMdzO-WCvEz_Eu2j00GecQNwk0j_2vuo/edit).

Children 12yo - 17yo NOT PERMITTED

You must register all attending children before arriving. To do this, complete this form so we are aware of the numbers in attendance. They will each be provided with their own wristband and welcoming smiles. :)

FESTIVAL INFORMATION

WHAT TO BRING

- Insect repellent, head torch, toothbrush, hat, raincoat, warm clothes, sunscreen, towel.
- Tent, tipi or swag, sleeping bag, pillow, matt for camp site and lights.
- Drinking water, snacks, cup for the bar, reusable drink bottle.
- Wet wipes or camping shower – there will be no shower facilities on site so please come prepared.

As we all know the Aussie lands are subject to large fluctuations in temperature so please come prepared for all weather conditions including extreme cold, rain and/or intense sun and heat...

Shoes must be worn at all times. The Winton Wetlands are home to snakes and other crawlies, so keep your paws protected.

WHAT NOT TO BRING (BANNED ITEMS)

The following items are not permitted to enter CHI WOW WAH TOWN for the safety of all Chi-Wow-Wian's & the surrounding environments. If banned items are found they will be confiscated during car search upon entry & during the event, so please leave them at home:

- Glass! (including glass alcohol, beverage or water bottles)
- Mirrors! (full length or detachable)
- Gas bottles (LPG or other)
- Cooking equipment or camping stoves – support our food vendors!
- Animals or pets (unless a registered assistance dogs – please **contact us** for approval before arriving)
- Fire, flares, fireworks, lasers, sparklers, weapons, candles or incense
- Generators
- Amplified sound or sound systems. Please respect our EPA guidelines
- Illicit substances of any type.
- Whipped cream chargers & canisters (aka 'Nangs)
- Antisocial behaviour or Bad vibes

Gates close Monday 26th Feb - all pups must be off-site by Midday, Monday.

Please be aware that anyone arriving on Thursday will not be granted access. Plan your trip accordingly so that you can be on site between the specified times.

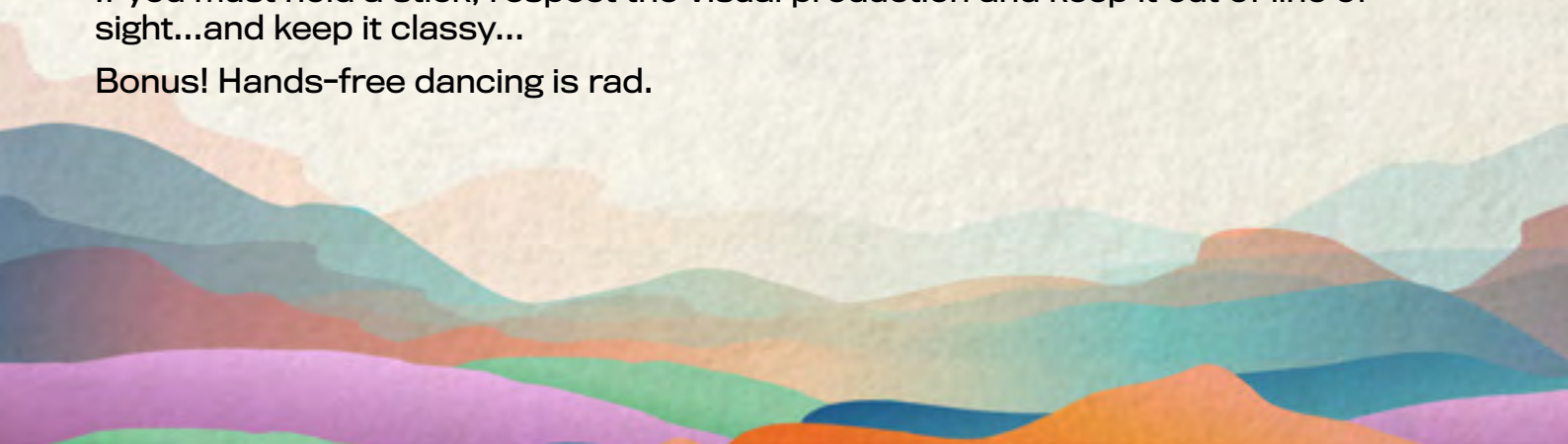
NO PHOTO / ANTISOCIAL (MEDIA) EVENT

DANCEWIZE

The team is a peer-run group of trained educators who specialise in alcohol and other drugs (AOD) support, providing care to intoxicated patrons and those experiencing any other kind of distress.

The DanceWize service also includes access to specialist trauma counsellors who are able to provide support to anyone experiencing difficulties in relation to gender based violence (for instance sexual assault), even if the experience is historic. These services are totally judgement-free and are there for the health and wellbeing of every person on site.
